



Monthly Guidelines for Riding Lessons

- Monthly payments are due on or before the first lesson of each month. Our non-profit rescue is very dependent upon a stable budget, therefore; we ask for a 30 day notice in the event of discontinuing lessons.
- Please arrive 15 mins before your scheduled lesson time so you may participate in the grooming and tacking of your horse. This increases the bond between horse and rider.
- It is important that riding students have a quiet, low pressured environment. We feel that parents should view a students lesson no more then one time a month. Please advise the trainer a week ahead for observation.
- Make up lessons are to be utilized within the month in which the lesson was missed. Most make ups will be given on a Saturday but is left to the trainers availability.
- Rainy days are inevitable in South Florida. We try to do our best to work around it, but when it is impossible we have built in rain sauces in our monthly schedule. There are 5 weeks in 3-4 months per calendar year. We continue to teach on that 5th week with no extra charge to overcome our weather issues.
- Please make sure your rider has what he or she needs each session. Some examples are plenty of water, a hand towel, gloves, britches, socks, etc.
